Building on her avid interest in politics, and her experience as an internet consultant, Lisa Daly will speak about the way political organizing has changed in recent years largely as a result of the Internet and online communication capabilities. Lisa Daly works as an internet consultant/technical project manager for LogicalSolutions.net, where she has advised several state and local Democratic campaigns on new media strategy. In the 2006 election cycle, she served on a volunteer basis as the Director of New Media for Dan Maffei's Congressional campaign in New York's 25th Congressional District. During the recent Presidential election cycle, she founded the group, "Syracuse for Obama," which led the central New York grassroots effort to elect Barack Obama, and in 2008, she was honored to attend the Democratic Convention as an Obama elected delegate. In 2005, Lisa earned a PhD in American History from the Maxwell School at Syracuse University.
